The applicant certifies that all information on this application is correct and the work will be completed in accordance with the “approved” construction documents and PA Act 45 (Uniform Construction Code) and any additional approved building code requirements adopted by the Municipality.

The property owner and applicant assume the responsibility of locating all property lines, setback lines, easements, rights-of-way, flood areas, etc.

Issuance of a permit and approval of construction documents shall not be construed as authority to violate, cancel or set aside any provisions of the codes or ordinances of the Municipality or any other governing body.

Authorized Agent Acknowledgement – I hereby certify that the proposed work is authorized by the owner of record and that I have been authorized by the owner to make this application as an authorized agent and agree to conform to all applicable regulations set forth by PA ACT 45. I also certify that I will bear the responsibility to request a final inspection of the project covered by this permit.

I certify that the code administrator or the code administrator’s authorized representative shall have the authority to enter areas covered by such permit at any reasonable hour to enforce the provisions of the code(s) applicable to such permit.

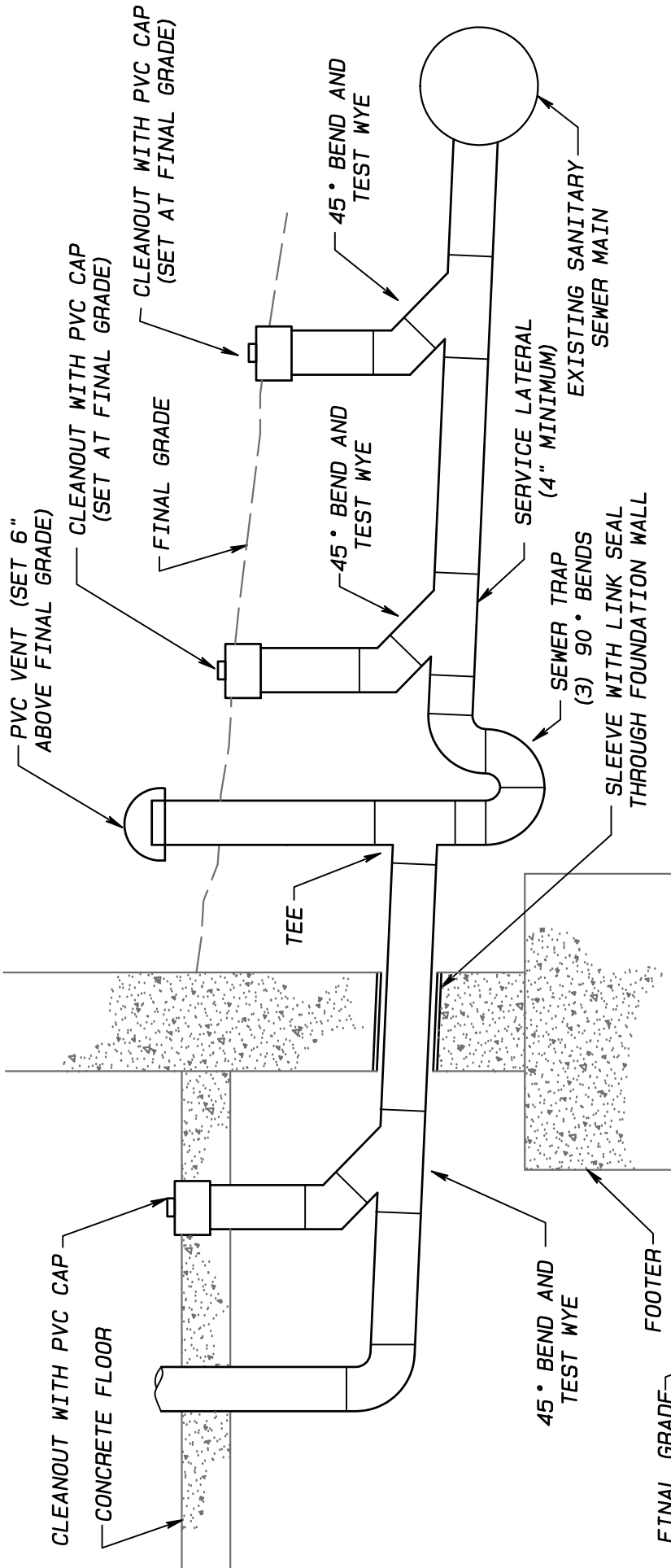
All returned checks will be assessed a \$25.00 penalty fee.

The following items should be in place and ready for inspection:

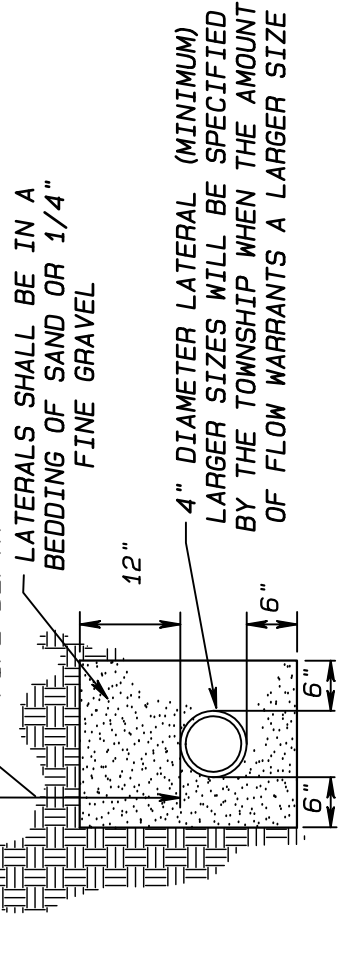
- The lateral should be exposed and pressurized
- Cleanouts and vents should be in place (ACCEPTED SEWER LATERAL DESIGN ATTACHED)
- Septic tanks should be filled with appropriate material and lids crushed
- SEWER AND WATER LINES MUST BE SEPARATED HORIZONTALLY BY AT LEAST 5 FEET OR THE WATER LINE MUST BE LOCATED AT LEAST 1 FOOT (VERTICALLY) ABOVE THE SEWER LINES.



NOTES:

1. LATERAL SLOPE SHALL BE 1/8" MINIMUM PER FOOT AND MUST COMPLY TO THE IPC STANDARDS AND REGULATIONS.
2. ALL PIPING MATERIAL INCLUDING TRAPS FOR GRAVITY APPLICATIONS SHALL BE SCHEDULE 40 PVC, ANSI/ASTM D2665 OR SDR 35.
3. ALL SCHEDULE 40 PVC PIPE USED FOR PRESSURE APPLICATIONS MAY BE STAMPED ASTM D2665 BUT MUST ALSO INCLUDE A SECOND NUMBER, EITHER ASTM D1785 OR ASTM F480, WHICH ARE PRESSURE DESIGNATIONS.
4. WORK MUST BE INSPECTED AND TESTED PRIOR TO BACKFILLING.
5. INSPECTION REQUIRING MORE THAN ONE VISIT TO THE SITE WILL BE BILLED AT \$65.00/INSPECTION.
6. CLEANOUTS MUST BE INSTALLED EVERY 75 FEET.
